- 1. Easter Greetings to one and all from the Parish Priest and all the Salesians of the Salesian Community.
- 2. Divine Mercy Novena began on Good Friday, and will end with the Feast of Divine Mercy on Easter Octave. Novena prayers will be said after the Morning Mass at 6.30 AM and at 5.30 PM in the evening in the Parish Church.
- 3. Next Sunday, 27<sup>th</sup> April, will be the Feast of Divine Mercy. At 3.00 PM Conclusion of the Divine Mercy Novena followed by Solemn Feast day Eucharist. There will not be a Holy Mass at 5.00 PM.
- 4. Easter House Blessings will begin from this week. Your zonal leaders will contact you to fix the time and date of the blessing, or you can also contact the zonal leaders to ascertain the time and date. Zonal Leaders, will need to get in touch with the Parish Priest to decide on the dates of blessing for your zone.
- 5. Children who have registered their names for receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation this year will have a special residential retreat, from Friday, 02nd May 2025 (4pm onwards) to Sunday, 04th May 2025 (5pm), here at Auxilium Church. It is an inter-diocesan Retreat, and it is compulsory for all the children registered for Confirmation. The cost for Accommodation and Food will be Rs. 500 for our parish members.
